TIME/DATE	ACTIVITIES		
1:00 PM September 7,2023	At around 1:00PM, personnel from Safety and Security Division, Medical Unit and Public Relations Division had a coordination meeting on the scenario to be re-enacted during the earthquake drill.		
	Chief Safety Officer MR. NIXON F. PAGCALIWAGAN started briefing the personnel on their involvement on the drill. Six (6) security officers equipped with megaphone was assigned to strategic areas to alert/alarm personnel occupying different offices and to assist them to the nearest exit going to the evacuation area.		
	Prior to the said activity, MS. DONNA JANE ORO set up a Command Post and served as Team Coordinator, MR. NIXON PAGCALIWAGAN served as the Incident Commander. Area intended for evacuation was also prepared at the flagpole by the Safety and Security Division Personnel.		
2:00 PM September 7, 2023	Around 2:00PM simulation drill started thru loud sirens from megaphones and ambulance served as alarms and were utilized by security personnel. LRTA personnel including Maintenance Transition Team (MTT) and different contractors equipped with safety helmet joined orderly the simultaneous evacuation proceeding going to the evacuation area.		
lac.	As soon as all involved personnel had lined-up in their respective designated area, all assigned focal persons started the head count of each personnel present and reported to the Command Post.		
	The Safety and Security Division (SSD) with Medical Rescue Unit also conducted actual search and rescue of one (1) victim from the lobby area to the ambulance on stand-by.

A total of 430 personnel participated in the simulation and based on the actual drill it took **four (4) minutes** for all personnel to be evacuated.

2:10PM September 7, 2023 Chief Safety Officer Nixon Pagcaliwagan gave brief information of the earthquake drill and its importance and goal.

At 2:10PM Chief Safety Officer Nixon Pagcaliwagan announced the earthquake simulation drill was completed and all individual employee's advice to return to their respective offices.
